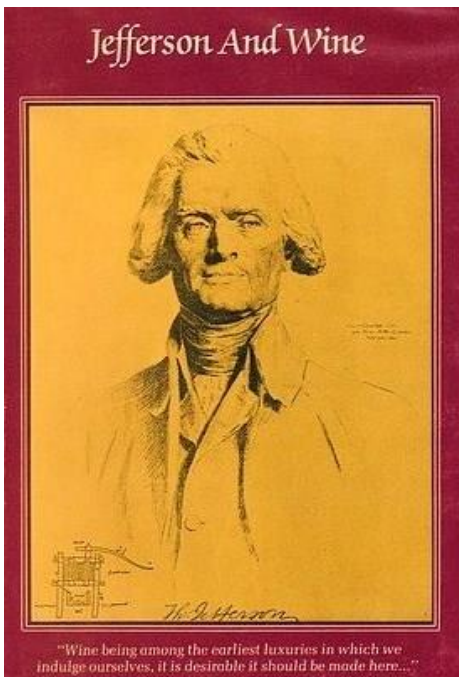

Jefferson's last known "purchasing list" for wines which indicates what he possessed in his cellar at Monticello a few months before he died. This refutes published claims that he had only Scuppernong wine at that time.
